Cushion covers, bed covers, bed sheets and cap bed sheets produced from woven fabric made of 100 % cotton and cotton/polyester, white, piece and yarn dyed and/or printed; jersey fitted sheets made of 100 % cotton, cotton/elastane and polyester/cotton, white, piece and yarn dyed; molleton covers produced from woven fabric made of 100 % cotton, white and raw white; terry towels and bathrobes made of 100 % cotton and cotton/polyester (in white), white, piece and yarn dyed; kitchen towels made of 100 % cotton, white and yarn dyed; hygiene articles (incontinence pads and coated fitted sheets) produced from velours made of 100 % polyester, with nonwoven, laminated with polyurethane wetness lock; patient gowns produced from woven fabric made of cotton/polyester, white, printed, piece and yarn dyed; table cloths produced from woven fabric made of 100 % cotton, 100 % polyester and their mixtures, white, piece and yarn dyed, including accessories (sewing threads, buttons, elastic and non-elastic tapes, woven and printed labels); produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Appendix 4, **product class II** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Appendix 4 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
